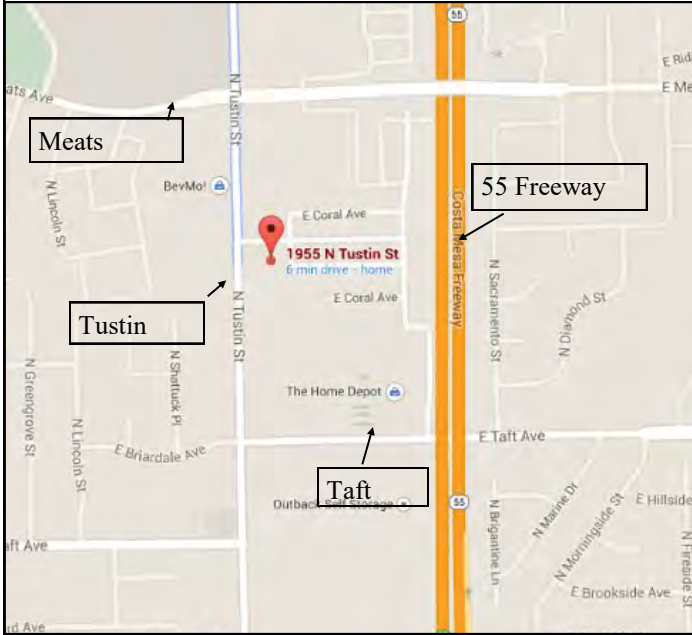
### Mentor's Corner
